- August 13 – The 2022 Touch-a-Truck event at Bridgewater Falls was very successful with a large turnout.
- Officer Roach assisted with the instruction of a police Jiu-Jitsu class attended by 25 officers who attended from Ohio, West Virginia, Nevada, New York, Maryland, and two cities in Canada.
- Officers, as well as members of the other township departments, stopped by and visited Cayden’s Lemonade Stand. This is Cayden’s third year of doing this fundraiser and the money raised goes to help kids in need of school supplies. Great job Cayden!
- Evening shift officers arrested a theft suspect who is part of a string of felony thefts occurring at Walmart. The suspect was arrested after pushing carts of merchandise out an emergency exit on the side of the building where a vehicle was waiting to pick him up. The suspect was booked into BC Jail on felony charges and additional charges are pending.
- 2500-block Urmston – Evening shift officers assisted Norwood PD with the apprehension of a felonious assault suspect wanted out of their jurisdiction, and later assisted NPD with a search warrant at the suspect’s home.
- 6700-block of Lester Avenue – the police department, along with the BC Regional SWAT Team, served a search warrant related to an ongoing investigation involving firearms, drugs, and other criminal offenses. Several people were arrested and numerous firearms, some of which were modified and stolen, were recovered from the scene.
