- It was another great year of bringing smiles to faces of those who are not able to have gifts for Christmas. Officers, along with volunteers from the CPAA, shopped, wrapped, and delivered presents to the houses of those in need.
- Update on investigation involving missing person Michael McKenney from June 2020 (*see news release on following page*).
- 12/03 – Officers responded to traffic issues where traffic lights were not functioning due to the high winds.
- 7200-block of East River Road – A female snuck into a family member’s bedroom during a holiday party and stole \$10, 000. The money was recovered and the suspect was arrested for the felony theft and booked into the BC Jail.
- Greenlawn Road for suspicious person ringing a doorbell and a strange car in the drive. Officers located a female sleeping in the backseat and her sister was at another house on the street. Officers arrested one of the females for felony warrants out of Hamilton Co. and officers located a white powdery substance on her. Charges pending.
- 6900-block of Morris Road. The driver went off the roadway and struck a house. It is suspected he may have been fleeing from an earlier crash when he did this. The driver was cited for multiple offense related to the two crashes.
- Officers responded to Imlay Avenue for a male subject acting erratically and laying on the ground. The subject was under the influence of methamphetamine and officers attempted numerous times to deescalate the situation; however, the subject would not cooperate. The subject pulled at his genitalia while almost exposing himself and was eventually arrested for disorderly conduct and booked into the BC Jail.

(FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP): On June 1, 2020, Fairfield Township Police received a report of a missing person, Michael Allen McKenney (then 28-year-old-male). Fairfield Township Police conducted a lengthy investigation into the whereabouts of Michael. Over the course of the last 2 ½ years, both private and public entities conducted searches in and around the area of the Hueston Woods State Park, near the Butler and Preble County border. Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) officials did locate Michael's vehicle and other personal belongings in Hueston Woods State Park very shortly after Michael's family members filed the missing person's report.

On December 7, 2022, search teams conducted a search around Hueston Woods State Park and did locate human remains. Preble County Coroner's Office took possession of those remains and continue to investigate.

Fairfield Township Police, ODNR, and the Preble County Coroner's Office are continuing to investigate.
