On June 9, 2023 – The victim of the Arroyo Ridge attack last month died due to her injuries. On June 21, 2023, a grand jury indicted the suspect, Robbi Davon Robinson, for aggravated murder with a death penalty spec. Robinson was also indicted on other charges related to that incident.

The agency held a promotional process for the position of sergeant and Officer Ryan Roach completed as the top candidate. He is scheduled for promotion to the rank of sergeant at the July 2023 trustees meeting.

The police department continues to expand its Wellness Program to include Mental Wellness Education and Checkups. A representative from Professional Counseling Services of Ohio, LLC spoke to police personnel at roll call about the program and to answer any questions. Officers will be participating in the program throughout the year.

Officer Robinson completed Advanced Dynamic Vehicle Operations at OPOTA. This course focused on vehicle handling, distracted driving, skid control, reversing, collision avoidance, emergency response, and pursuit driving. There was also a review of legal issues about operating a police vehicle as well as officer safety tips and concerns.

Sergeant Miller and Officer Green attended the 8-hour Vehicle Engagements training through Norse Tactical.

Breaking and Entering – Multiple suspects broke into Unique Jewelry and Fashion on Hamilton-Middletown Road and stole money and property. This case remains under investigation.

A 36-year-old female was indicted by a grand jury for multiple felony drug charges stemming from a search warrant in March 2023.

A 61-year-old male was indicted by a grand jury on June 9th on several felony counts for pandering obscenity involving a minor and illegal use of a minor in nudity material.

June 3, 2023 – The police department had the privilege of participating in the Fairfield Township Veterans Memorial Dedication and parade.
