September 25th – 19-year-old Jordan Spain plead guilty to involuntary manslaughter for his involvement in the 2018 killing of 16-year-old Sydney Garcia Tovar in Tyler's Creek Apartments. Detectives arrested Spain back in September 2022 and another suspect, Markeylnd Townsend, in April 2021. Townsend's case is pending in Butler County Common Pleas Court and Spain's sentencing date is November 1, 2023.

The police department worked the 1st Annual Fairfield Township Car Show and Concert at Heroes' Park. The primary focus was the safety of everyone which included efficient traffic flow during ingress and egress, pedestrian traffic, and bike and foot patrols. It was also a good community engagement occasion between the police officers and the community.

Officer Zach Steele and Officer Trenton Smith completed their one-year probationary period in September. Congratulations to both officers as they continue their career here in Fairfield Township.

Officers responded to SR4 near Millikin Road for a fatal crash involving a car and a motorcycle. The investigation determined that the motorcycle operator was slowing or stopped at the intersection (northbound) on SR4 at Millikin

Road. A car that was travelling in the same direction struck him from behind and the motorcycle operator was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the car was arrested on September 29th and charged with vehicular manslaughter. The driver of another car was charged with leaving the scene of a crash.

A child was struck by a car on Walden Ponds at Vonnie Vale in the crosswalk area. The child was transported by medical helicopter for medical treatment and is now home and recovering.

Michael Wine was sentenced to 18 months in prison following an investigation and arrest pertaining to child pornography.
