December 2, 2023 – The police department partnered with Walmart for the annual “Fill a Cruiser” event. This year’s donation collections amounted to 1,748 lbs. of food and \$164.00 for the Fairfield Food Pantry. Thank you to all of those who made this event possible and to everyone for their generous donations and support.

We received our Body Armor Grant payment for the 2023-24 grant. The total portion reimbursed was \$6,721.49.

The police department participated in the Ohio Collaboration certification process and has been deemed compliant with the designated standards as established by the Ohio Collaborative Community-Police Advisory Board.

Officers worked additional traffic enforcement details on grant overtime during the holidays and made several OVI-related arrests as well as the enforcement of other traffic offenses.

Officers responded to Game Stop for a suspect attempting to steal items and assaulting an employee. The officers conducted a thorough investigation at the scene and positively identified the suspect and an address for him. Officers located the suspect at a house in Hamilton and successfully negotiated for him to come outside where they took him into custody. The suspect was booked in the BC Jail and charged with robbery.

A female suspect stole over \$3,500 in merchandise from Ulta Beauty in Bridgewater Falls. The suspect was later identified charges are pending.

A male subject attempted to kick in the door and gain entry inside the apartment belonging to his child’s mother (victim). The victim was home at the time and called the police due to the current situation and the suspect’s violent history. The suspect fled prior to the officers arriving on the scene and warrants were issued for attempted burglary, theft, and domestic violence.
