Dear Shelly:

This is to advise that an ACH payment in the amount of \$27,661.96 in payment of Fairfield Township's net collections for the J.E.D.D. I, II, and III will be forthcoming. This is in accordance with the J.E.D.D. Board Directive September 1, 2005 to have the distributions made monthly.

For the calculations pertaining to the balance for distribution of funds for March 2021 we now have the original J.E.D.D. (categorized as J.E.D.D. I), the first amendment adding area to the original J.E.D.D. (categorized as J.E.D.D. II), and the second amendment adding additional area to the original J.E.D.D. (categorized as J.E.D.D. III). The total available for distribution (net of refunds and commissions) for March 2021 for J.E.D.D. I is -\$114,078.53 (See J.E.D.D. I collections attachment). The J.E.D.D. agreement determined that the distributions for J.E.D.D. I will be paid 75% to the City of Hamilton and 25% to Fairfield Township. The distribution according to that criteria would result in a payment of \$0.00 to the City of Hamilton and a payment of \$0.00 to Fairfield Township. The March 2021 overage of -\$114,078.53 will be reduced from the next months J.E.D.D. I collections until balanced.

The total available for distribution (net of refunds and commissions) for March 2021 for J.E.D.D. II is \$36,872.47 (see J.E.D.D. II collections attachment). The J.E.D.D. agreement determined that the distribution for J.E.D.D. II will be paid 25% to the City of Hamilton and 75% to Fairfield Township. The distribution according to that criteria would result in a payment of \$9,218.12 to the City of Hamilton and a payment of \$27,654.35 to Fairfield Township.

The total available for distribution (net of refunds and commissions) for March 2021 for J.E.D.D. III is \$15.22 (see J.E.D.D. III collections attachment). The J.E.D.D. agreement determined that the distribution for J.E.D.D. III will be paid 50% to the City of Hamilton and 50% to Fairfield Township. The distribution according to that criteria would result in a payment of \$7.61 to the City of Hamilton and a payment of \$7.61 to Fairfield Township.

The total combined amount due to the City of Hamilton is \$9,225.73. The total combined amount due to Fairfield Township is \$27,661.96.
