**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PURCHASE OF ACTIVE SHOOTER PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT FROM  
GALLS, 1905 DALTON AVE., CINCINNATI, OHIO 45214, FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT,  
AT A TOTAL COST OF \$7,306.65.**

**WHEREAS:** The Chief of Police has determined there is a need to provide extra protection for police personnel when responding to high-threat critical incidents, to include active shooters; and

**WHEREAS:** Like and similar equipment has been purchased in the past; and

**WHEREAS:** This will be purchased out of Fund No. 2081-210-251.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

**SECTION 1:** The Board hereby approves the purchase of Active Shooter protective equipment from Galls, 1905 Dalton Ave., Cincinnati, Ohio 45214 for the Police Department, at a total cost of \$7,306.65, and authorizes the Administrator to execute the Sales Quotation attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

**SECTION 3** This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

**SECTION 4:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5:** This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

SUBJECT: Request to Purchase Safety/Protective Equipment

Mrs. Vonderhaar:

In continuing to review equipment needs for the Fairfield Township Police Department and reviewing current inventories, it has been determined that there were 17 Active Shooter response kits purchased and issued to 17 officers in the past as the then-authorized strength of 19 had not been met. As we now have a total of 21 authorized officers, I am requesting to purchase 5 more kits to outfit the four additional officers and have one spare kit if needed. The Active Shooter kits include a Kevlar helmet, 2 rifle rated plates (front and back) for each carrier, and "Police" lettering for the carriers. Additionally, we now have two officers assigned to the Butler County Regional SWAT Team that require green colored helmets.

As you are aware active shooter/killer situations tragically continue and no municipality is immune. Recently, as in other cases, a suspect used an AR15 rifle to kill innocent victims and shoot police officers at the Tree of Life Congregation Synagogue in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He was also armed with 3 Glock pistols. One of the responding SWAT officers was shot multiple times and struck in the vest and helmet. While the officer received significant injuries from blunt force trauma, he fortunately survived as the rifle plates and the helmet either absorbed or deflected the rounds. The protection offered by the kits are similar to the protective equipment used by personnel responding to the Pittsburgh incident.

The following item being requested are:

- 10 rifle rated plates (front and back) - \$311.10 each/\$3111.00 total
- 5 plate black carriers - \$83.13 each/\$415.65 total with Police lettering included
- 7 helmets - \$540 each/\$3,780.00 total (5 black = 2 green)

Total: **\$7,306.65**

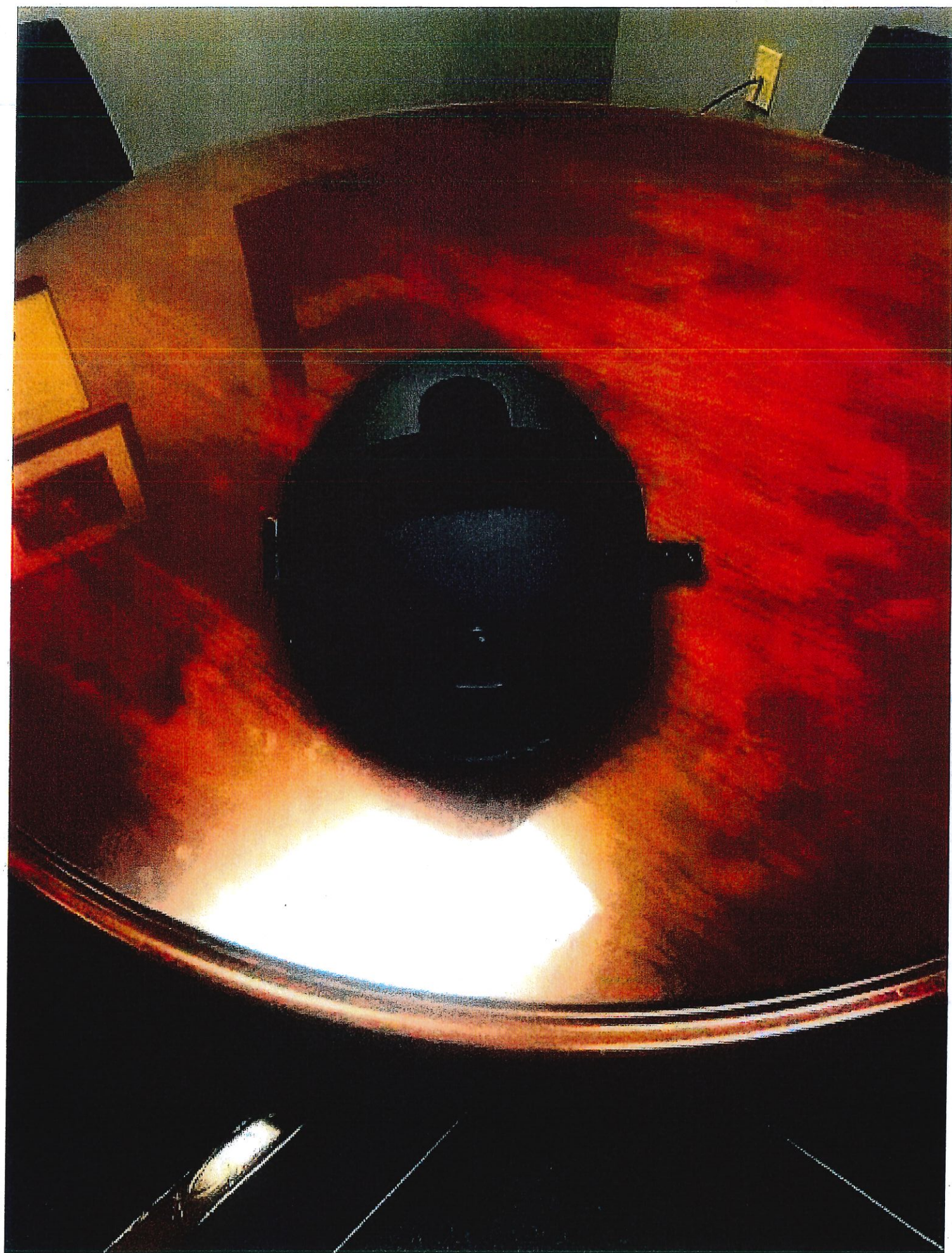

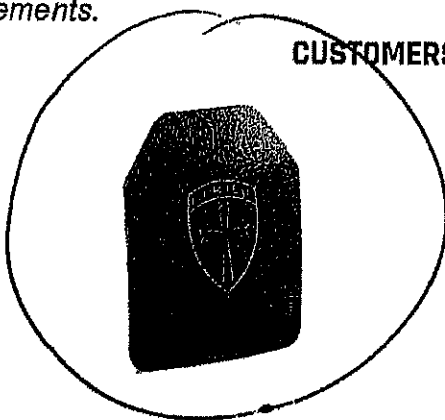

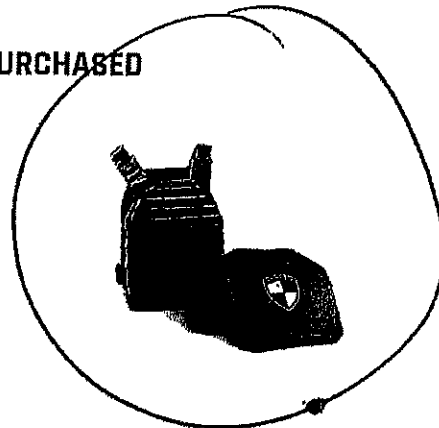
