**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PURCHASE PER STATE CONTRACT, A NEW 2020 E-ONE
FIRE ENGINE FROM VOGELPOHL FIRE EQUIPMENT INC., FOR THE FIRE
DEPARTMENT IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$549,258.00.**

WHEREAS: The Fire Chief has recommended the purchase of a new fire engine to enhance the safety and welfare of the residents of Fairfield Township; and

WHEREAS: The selected bid provides the lowest, best bid, for the desired equipment; and

WHEREAS: The Board has determined that the current budget can sustain this purchase in the Public Safety Levy Fund No. 2191;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

SECTION 1: The Board hereby approves the purchase of a new Fire Engine from Vogelphol Fire Equipment Inc., for the Fire Department in the total amount of \$549, 258.00, per State Contract, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.



SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.







Prepayment Options

The price bid assumes no payment until delivery and acceptance of completed fire apparatus. For a full or partial prepayment the following discounts are available:

100% Prepayment	\$15,112
75% Prepayment	\$12,950
50% Prepayment	\$8,633

Discounts shown are based on the bid amount of \$575,562 and delivery time of 365 days.

The 100% prepayment discount is based upon type of apparatus, content, and contract price. It is subject to adjustment by E-One based upon final contract amount, with discounted payment due with contract submission.

For partial prepayments, actual discount will be calculated at 3% simple interest annual rate from the day funds are received at E-One until the apparatus is ready for shipment at the factory, and applied as a deduct on the final invoice.

The apparatus sale price quoted does not include a performance bond. A performance bond is available from E-One at a cost of \$4.00 per \$1,000 of contract price. A performance bond is recommended for any order involving a pre-payment, and normally required by Lessors for pre-funded municipal lease purchases.

Pre-funded Municipal Lease Purchase

The following finance package is offered through the lease company (Lessor) listed below. It assumes that the Purchaser enters into a lease agreement with the Lessor at the same time as entering a contract with E-One for the apparatus purchase, and forwards the proceeds of the lease to E-One as a prepayment with the purchase order/contract. The first lease payment would be due one (1) year after signing of the Lease Agreement, and annually thereafter. Interest Rates quoted are current as of 8/26/2019 and indexed to 5 year Treasury Swaps. Interest rates and payment are subject to change based on final purchase amount and interest in effect at time of lease signing.

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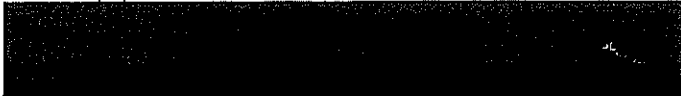
