**RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2019 APPROPRIATIONS.**

**WHEREAS:** The Fiscal Officer recommends the appropriations for Fund No. 2191 be increased by \$100,000.00; and

**WHEREAS:** The Board has determined that the current budget can sustain this increase from within the Public Safety Levy Fund No. 2191;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

**SECTION 1:** The Board hereby amends the 2019 Permanent Appropriations Budget amounts, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

**SECTION 3** This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

**SECTION 4:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5:** This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
