**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF ^{(3) THREE} ~~(2) TWO~~ 2020 FORD INTERCEPTOR
SUV'S FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM LEBANON FORD WITH STATE BID
PRICING, AT A TOTAL COST OF \$65,308.00.**

WHEREAS: The Police Chief for the year of 2019 budgeted to purchase two of these vehicles at a cost of \$32,654.00 per vehicle; and

WHEREAS: The purchase of the vehicles is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of both Fairfield Township Police Officers and residents; and

WHEREAS: The vehicles will be purchased out of Safety Service Fund No. 2191;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

SECTION 1: The Board hereby approves the purchase of ^{(3) three} ~~(2) two~~ 2020 Ford Interceptor SUV's for the Police Department from Lebanon Ford where State Bid pricing was utilized, at a total cost of \$65,308.00, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SUBJECT: Marked Car Purchase Update

Mrs. Vonderhaar:

As you are aware, the Fairfield Township Police Department has historically purchased two vehicles per year in order to accommodate the Police Department's needs. This is based on a five-year vehicle rotation plan. It is my understanding that although the authorized strength of the Department was 19 prior to my arrival, the actual number of Officers assigned to the Department fell well short of that number. In fact, I have not been able to confirm that FTPD ever actually maintained 19. In August 2017 when I became the Chief we had 17 Officers and as the result of attrition we went down to 15 with 13 assigned to patrol. As you are aware, we will soon be at 21 with 17 assigned to patrol, which is the updated authorized strength based on the Trustees' approval and have received very positive feedback from the community on the increase of our personnel. Our personnel have been advised by citizens during community meetings that they have witnessed more officer presence in their neighborhoods than in the past. Ironically, this has also caused more requests to address crime and disorder issues. We also have one additional part-time School Resource Officer (SRO) position paid for by Butler Tech. This Officer also uses a marked unit during the school year.

As a result of our increased staffing, which places more uniform officers in patrol cars on the street, and the significant maintenance costs and down time of our 2014 Dodge Chargers, I am requesting to purchase three 2020 Ford Interceptors (2019s are not available anymore) at a cost of \$32,654.00 each, which is the Ohio State Bid pricing from Lebanon Ford. The additional vehicle would allow us to increase our fleet by one and shorten the amount of time we can trade-in the Chargers in order to minimize the maintenance cost and downtime caused by repairs.

A review of our fleet shows that the four marked 2014 Dodge Chargers have cost us the following maintenance during the last two years:

- #401: \$3,996.19 (\$3323.16 invoice pending)
 - #402: \$4,231.35
 - #403: \$6,567.87
 - \$404: \$2,700.01
- TOTAL: \$17,495.42 + \$3323.16 = \$20,818.58**

In the past we have also spent \$12,781.95 per vehicle on accessories. I have included the \$25,562.90 2018 Quote for from Camp Safety, 8216 Blue Ash Rd. Cincinnati, Ohio 45236 for two vehicles recently purchased. We are currently researching P & R Communication, 700 E. 1st St., Dayton, Ohio 45402 as a new vendor for the accessories as the result of more contemporary accessories available and their ability to do installs onsite instead of having to take the vehicle to them. As you recall, P & R is the vendor that installed our WatchGuard in-car cameras. Thus far, it seems their install was top quality and they have been very responsive in addressing any issues.

Prior to taking the Ford Expedition out of service due to age, we had 13 uniform Officers utilizing 10 cars during a 24/7 cycle. Due to the increase in staffing, we now have 17 Officers utilizing 9 cars during a 24/7 cycle.

While we will be contacting P & R in the near future to obtain a quote on outfitting our new vehicles, I am requesting that we purchase the three 2020 Ford Explorer for a total of \$97,962.00 as soon as possible as these vehicles are very popular and are already backlogged. Keep in mind that the Board of Trustees approved the purchase order of two 2018 Ford Explorers on 4/26/2018. However, as the 2018 inventory was already exhausted in April, we received 2019 models in October (6 months later). Even though Lebanon Ford has advised that, if ordered soon, the vehicles will arrive in late summer, there may be a like-and-similar delay.

Additionally, due to a delay on obtaining accessories this year, the 2019 models are still not operational at this time but anticipate them being fully operational in the next few weeks.
