RESOLUTION TO APPROVE REPAIR WORK TO BE DONE AT THE SHAFERS RUN PARK WALKING PATH FROM BARRY L. BROWN PAVING, AT A TOTAL COST OF \$28,000.00.

WHEREAS: Three proposals were received, and Barry L. Brown Paving was most cost effective and responsible based upon the combination of price and experience; and

WHEREAS: This will be purchased out of Fund No. 2906;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

SECTION 1: The Board hereby approves the repair work to be done at the Shafer's Run Park walking path from Barry L. Brown Paving at a total cost of \$28,000.00, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

2) Install 4" 304 crushed aggregate in the excavated area and compact.	
3) Install 2.5" 448 Type 1 asphalt surface course over the compacted gravel base.	
Note: This price is based on leaving all excavation spoils on site.	
Concrete Sidewalk Extension - 6 square yards	\$1,510.00
1) Excavate the new sidewalk area to a depth of 6".	
2) Install 6" Class C concrete in the excavated area.	
3) Broom finish the concrete and install control joints as necessary.
