**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE REPAIR OF STORM SEWER PIPING ON CITATION DRIVE
AND PREAKNESS LANE FROM T.S. GARNETT CONSTRUCTION, INC.,
AT A TOTAL COST OF \$35,000.00.**

WHEREAS: Repair of storm sewer piping is needed at Citation Drive and Preakness Lane; and

WHEREAS: Three quotes have been received and T. S. Garnett Construction, Inc. is recommended for the pipe repair, out of Fund No. ~~2906~~;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

SECTION 1: The Board hereby approves the repair of the storm sewer connection on Citation Drive and Preakness Lane by T.S. Garnett Construction, Inc., at a total cost of \$35,000.00, as set forth on attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3: This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

A. Scope of Work:

1. Furnish equipment, labor, and materials providing a minimum 3" thick paved invert with mesh. (3" at Invert). SMITHCORP crews to remove debris from invert and divert flow for placement of mesh and concrete. SMITHCORP to supply minimum 4,000psi. concrete. We will have 1 mobilization included for the duration of our work. SMITHCORP will assist in the planning and schedule requested by Fairfield Township to help in the preparation.

B. Unit Price for Proposed Work:

MOBILAZATION: \$2,500.⁰⁰ dollars.

1. Scope of Work "A": Concrete pave 42" CMP Invert 169 LF at \$221.00 LF **\$37,349.⁰⁰** dollars.

C. Exclusions to Scope:

1. No premiums for payment of special insurance.
2. Any required independent engineering, and / or pre-construction and post-construction surveys and testing of any kind are excluded from this proposal.
3. Our bid does not include any provisions for the identification of, exposure to, and / or disposal of hazardous or contaminated materials. Should these materials be encountered, or our personnel be exposed, we reserve the right to stop our work and delay time shall begin to accrue. Once the site is remedied by others, the Sub-Contractor shall return to work. Downtime rate for our crew is \$500.00 per hour. Crew will work 4 days at 10-hours per day.
4. Any required independent engineering, inspection, or testing services, and / or pre-construction and post-construction surveys are excluded from this proposal. The project Owner shall provide all permits, fees, and permission of adjacent property owners that may be required for the performance our work, except for those required for the transportation of our equipment and any state or local contractor's licensees.
5. Location of public and private utilities and the holding or movement of those existing utilities. Engineering, survey/layout, and as-builts.
6. Providing line and grade stakes, permits, inspection fees, traffic control and access for rubber tire vehicles by their own power.
7. Flagmen, barrier walls, track supports and RR. 24 hour a day crew boring requirement.
8. Furnishing and installing carrier pipe, wood blocking, casing spacers and special end seals and filling of the annular space.

9. All settlement monitoring and ground stabilization that may be required. Any grouting of voids around the exterior of the CMP.
10. All temporary and permanent fencing requirements, maintenance of traffic, haul road construction and maintenance of those roads, including dust control.
11. SMITHCORP to provide a site safety plan. Others to provide a total job safety plan, full time safety director and additional measures if required for the total project.
12. All excavation: including machine pits and receiving pits per OSHA standards either tight sheeted, or trench box systems. Hand railed and fenced. Including fall protection, with ladder cages for work pits.
13. Required equipment pads for any required crane or excavator.
14. Water supply accessible to work site.
15. Soil dewatering. Maintenance of any flows, including trench waters in machine and receiving pits. Dewatering to 24" below the invert of casing for entire length of the crossing and the pit areas. SMITHCORP will provide low flow by-pass pumping to complete our work. Soil erosion measures and the maintenance of those measures.
16. Proposal made part of AIA DOC#A401-2017 valid for only 30 days from date.

D. Compensation and Dispute Resolution:

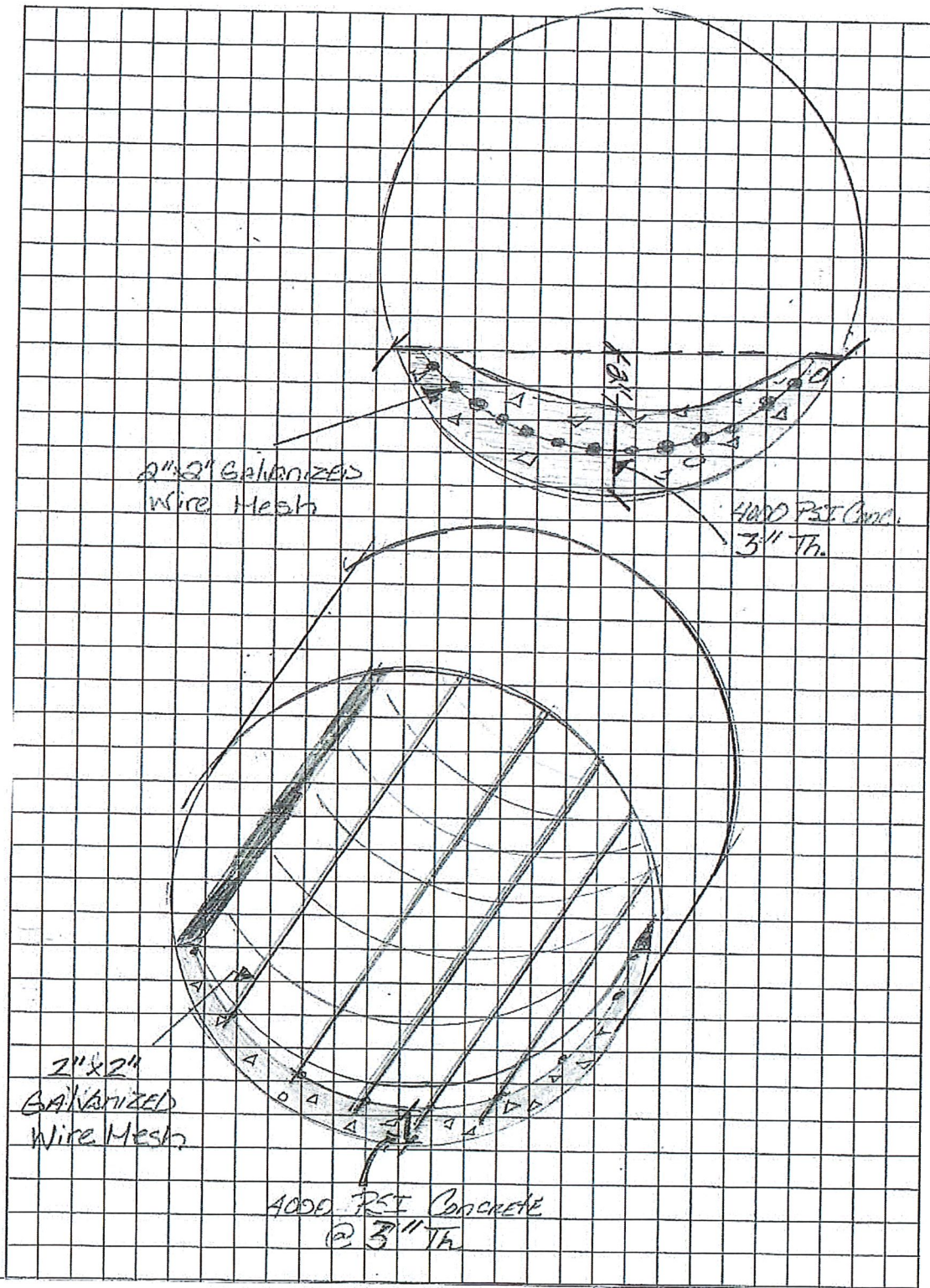
1. The project Owner/Contractor agrees to pay the Sub-Contractor (SMITHCORP) within 10 days of the date of Sub-Contractor's invoice. The project Owner/Contractor agrees to be invoiced by SMITHCORP monthly until the project is complete. No retainage to be held.
2. Both Parties, the project Owner/Contractor, and the Sub-Contractor (SMITHCORP), agree to the following three provisions:
 - a) Both Parties agree to arbitrate all disputes.
 - b) In the event of a successful collection action by SMITHCORP against the project Owner/Contractor, the project Owner/Contractor agrees to pay SMITHCORP interest on the owed principal at the prime rate plus 1.5 percent.
 - c) In the event of a successful collection action by SMITHCORP against the project Owner/Contractor, the project Owner/Contractor agrees to provide complete recovery for SMITHCORP's attorney fees. Venue of law Hamilton County Ohio.
