FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 20-174

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PROMOTION OF POLICE OFFICER MATTHEW MILLER TO SERGEANT'S POSITION, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS: The Police Chief has expressed the need to fill a Sergeant vacancy left by the retirement of Sergeant James Souhrada;

WHEREAS: The Sergeant's Assessment was conducted on October 10, 2020, by the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police (OACP); and

WHEREAS: Based on his first placement on the Assessment and subsequent interview, Officer Matthew Miller has been recommended for promotion to Sergeant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

- SECTION 1: The Board hereby approves the promotion of Police Officer Matthew Miller to Sergeant's position, effective immediately, and specifically finds that he has the qualifications previously specified by the Township for that position. He will serve a one-year probationary period as Sergeant from the date of his appointment at an hourly rate of \$38.83 per/hr.
- **SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.
- SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
