RESOLUTION NO. 20-80

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A THEN AND NOW PURCHASE ORDER FOR PHASE I CURB AND GUTTER REPAIRS FROM SAM AND MIKE NEAL CONTRACTOR'S AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$44,999.00.

WHEREAS: The maintenance and repairs of curb and gutters are one of the primary responsibilities of Townships; and

WHEREAS: Improved curb & gutters will benefit the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Fairfield Township; and

WHEREAS: Use of repair processes including curb and gutter will prolong road life and improve road conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

SECTION 1: The Board hereby authorizes the Phase I repair and improvement of curb and gutter at a total cost not to exceed \$44,999.00, from Sam and Mike Neal Contractors, for those roads on the list, attached hereto as Exhibit "A". This will be purchased out of Fund No. 2906

SECTION 2: The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
