**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE EQUIPMENT AND MUNITIONS TO CONDUCT SCENARIO BASED  
TRAINING IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AT A COST OF \$7,455.79**

**WHEREAS:** The Police Chief believes scenario-based training will benefit the health, safety and welfare of the officers in the department and the residents of Fairfield Township; and

**WHEREAS:** The equipment necessary for the training will be paid for from Safety Service Fund No. 2191; and

**WHEREAS:** The attached vendor was researched and provide good products at a fair price and are the sole vendors to sell the products;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Board hereby approves equipment and munitions in order to conduct scenario-based training for new Police Officers at a cost of \$7,455.79, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

**SECTION 3** This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

**SECTION 4:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5:** This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
