**RESOLUTION NO. 21-104**

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 TAX BUDGET, ATTACHED HERETO  
AND MADE A PART OF THIS RESOLUTION BY REFERENCE.**

**WHEREAS:** The Board of Trustees is required to adopt a tax budget for the ensuing fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS:** Two copies of the proposed budget have been on file with the Fiscal Officer since June 15, 2021; and

**WHEREAS:** Public notice of the hearing was given by a newspaper having general circulation in the Township, to wit: the Hamilton Journal News, published on June 15, 2021; and

**WHEREAS:** The Board of Trustees conducted a public hearing on the budget on July 14, 2021;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

**SECTION 1:** The attached Annual Budget for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2022, is hereby approved by the Fairfield Township Board of Trustees, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 2:** The Fiscal Officer is required to submit the adopted budget to the County Auditor on or before July 20, 2021.

**SECTION 3:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

**SECTION 4:** This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.

**SECTION 5:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 6:** This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.




