RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR DISPATCH SERVICES WITH THE BUTLER COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, AT A TOTAL COST OF \$225,000,000 FOR 2022.

WHEREAS: The operational costs of the Butler County Sheriff's Dispatch will be shared with the Fairfield Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS: The Memorandum of Understanding contains a formula establishing the annual cost, the Township shall be notified annually of the fees; and

WHEREAS: The Agreement contributes to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Fairfield Township and will taken out of Fund No. 2191;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

- SECTION 1: The Board hereby authorizes the Administrator to execute the Butler County Sheriff's Dispatch Services Memorandum of Understanding, at a total cost of \$225,000.00, as set forth on the attached Exhibit "A".
- **SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.
- SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 5:** This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

Memorandum of Understanding for Dispatch Services

- 1. THIS AGREEMENT, made on the <u>GTH</u> day of <u>DECEMBER</u>, <u>DO21</u>, between the Board of County Commissioners of Butler County, Ohio, herein referred to as the COUNTY, and FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP.
 - 2. THE AUTHORITY to enter into such agreement provided under Part 90.175 and 90.179 of the Federal Communications Commission Rules and Regulations and Section 128.03(E) of the Ohio Revised Code and as specified in the Butler County 911 Final Plan.
 - 3. THE COUNTY agrees to provide dispatching services as determined appropriate by the Butler County Sheriff's Office. Said dispatching responsibilities will be governed in full accord with those legal obligations as mandated by federal, state and county governments having jurisdiction over such matters. The day-to-day operation and administration of the system will be governed by standards in accordance with operational procedures established by the Butler County Sheriff's Office that are dedicated to such services, including those set by the Butler County 800 Megahertz Advisory Board, the Butler County 911 Planning Committee and the State of Ohio ESINet Steering Committee.
 - 4. THE TOWNSHIP agrees to operate in full accord with those legal obligations as mandated by federal, state and county governments having jurisdiction over such matters and the Butler County 800 Megahertz Advisory Board, the Butler County 911 Planning Committee and the State of Ohio ESINet Steering Committee.
 - 5. BOTH PARTIES to this contract agree to cooperate in the orderly exchange of information as may become necessary through committees and/or advisory boards or other such avenues of intercommunications in the development of system standards and operational procedures applicable to the specific radio service under which these parties are eligible to operate.

6. COSTS

(a.) Costs shall be billed in arrears on a monthly basis to all law enforcement users as a pro rata share of the most recent full year expended dispatch center budget. Each user's monthly share shall be calculated according the user's previous full year calls for services and push-to talks, divided by twelve. (E.G. 2022 billing would be based on 2020 expended budget for the dispatch center, pro-rated according to the user's 2020 calls for service and push-to-talk numbers.)

- (b.) After the first year, no annual user billing shall increase or decrease by an amount exceeding three (3) percent.
- (c.) Billings to the Cities of Hamilton and Oxford shall be phased into the formula stated in paragraph (a.) due to previously existing agreements from which increases and decreases shall be limited to no more than three (3) percent annually until such time as their billings correspond to the formula in paragraph (a.) above.


