RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FIRE CHIEF TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT WITH BUTLER TECH DONATING EQUIPMENT IN EXCHANGE FOR TRAINING SERVICES.

WHEREAS: This agreement between Fairfield Township Board of Trustees and Butler Tech is intended as a sale of equipment in exchange for training resources having equal value; and

WHEREAS: The Township shall transfer to Butler Tech for its use in the school fire education program a 1997 Sutphen Pumper, in "As Is Condition"; and

WHEREAS: Butler Tech in return will allow the Fairfield Township Fire Department to send individuals to training located at 5140 Princeton Glendale Road, Liberty Township, OH 45011. Training will consist of tuition only and does not cover the cost of books or associated fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

- **SECTION 1:** That the Board authorizes the Administrator to execute the agreement with Butler Tech.
- **SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.
- SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 5:** This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
