FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 21-74

RESOLUTION REQUESTING BUTLER COUNTY ENGINEER CONDUCT AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION ON MORRIS ROAD BETWEEN PRINCETON ROAD AND MILLIKIN ROAD.

WHEREAS: A request has been made to this Board that the currently journalized vehicular speed limit previously established by the Director of Highways and recorded as Revision #8107 and Revision #45305 is greater (or less) than that considered reasonable and safe on Morris Road between Princeton Road and Millikin road and;

WHEREAS: The Board is requesting an engineering and traffic investigation upon the section of road described above; and

WHEREAS: It is the belief of this Board that such investigation will confirm the belief that the current journalized speed limit of 45 mph is unrealistic;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

- **SECTION 1:** The Board hereby approves the Butler County Engineer to conduct an engineering and traffic investigation on Morris Road between Princeton Road and Millikin Road.
- **SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.
- SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- **SECTION 4:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
