FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 22-107

RESOLUTION APPOINTING CHUCK O'BRYON AS PART-TIME RESOURCE OFFICER (SRO), AT AN HOURLY WAGE OF \$35.00 PER HOUR WITH A 12 MONTH PROBATIONARY PERIOD.

WHEREAS: The Chief of Police has indicated the need to fill a vacancy for a part-time School Resource Officer position for Butler Tech; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Trustees, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, has determined Chuck O'Bryon has demonstrated he possess the necessary education, skills, training and experience to effectively fulfill the duties of School Resource Officer; and

WHEREAS: The Board desires to appoint Mr. O'Bryon as School Resource Officer with a beginning hourly wage of \$35.00 per hour and \$13,922.30 to be paid in a 12-month period for the cost of the employee's insurance. Additionally, Mr. O'Bryon will have a 12-month probationary period. All of Mr. O'Bryon's wages and benefits as the School Resource Officer will be paid by Butler Tech.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

- The Board hereby approves the appointment of Chuck O'Bryon to the position of part-time School Resource Officer at an hourly wage of \$35.00 per hour with \$13,922.30 to be paid in a 12-month period for the cost of the employee's insurance. Additionally, Mr. O'Bryon will have a 12-month probationary period.
- This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. The Trustees of Fairfield Township upon majority vote do hereby dispense with any requirements that this resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.
- **SECTION 5.** This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
