FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 22-132

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR DISPATCH SERVICES WITH THE BUTLER COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, AT A TOTAL COST OF \$197,282.18 FOR 2023.

WHEREAS: The operational costs of the Butler County Sheriff's Dispatch will be shared with the Fairfield Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS: The Memorandum of Understanding contains a formula establishing the annual cost, the Township shall be notified annually of the fees; and

WHEREAS: The Agreement contributes to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Fairfield Township and will be taken out of Fund No. 2191;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

- SECTION 1: The Board hereby authorizes the Administrator to execute the Butler County Sheriff's Dispatch Services Memorandum of Understanding, at a total cost of \$197,282.18, as set forth on the attached Exhibit "A".
- SECTION 2: The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.
- SECTION 3 This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
