RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CRACK SEAL TO BE PURCHASED FROM DJL MATERIALS AND SUPPLY INC., AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.00.

WHEREAS: The maintenance and repairs of roads is one of the primary responsibilities of Townships;

WHEREAS: Improved roads will benefit the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Fairfield Township;

WHEREAS: Use of repair processes including, but not limited to, Durapatch, milling, hot patch and crack sealing will prolong road life and improve road conditions;

WHEREAS: This will be taken from Fund #2272; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

- **SECTION 1:** The Board hereby authorizes the purchase of crack seal at a total cost not to exceed \$10,000.00 from DJL Materials and Supply Inc., P.O. Box 5293, Akron, OH, 44334, attached hereto as Exhibit "A". This will be purchased out of Fund No. 2272.
- **SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.
- **SECTION 3:** This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 5:** This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
