**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF FIVE (5) FULL-TIME  
POLICE OFFICER POSITIONS.**

**WHEREAS:** Increased staffing of the Police Department will contribute to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Fairfield Township; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows;

**SECTION 1:** The Board hereby authorizes the creation of five (5) full-time police officer positions for the Police Department.

**SECTION 2:** The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

**SECTION 3** This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.




