RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF NEW 2026 FORD E450 AMBULANCE FROM MEDIX SPECIALTY VEHICLES, PER STATE CONTRACT, FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000.00.

WHEREAS: The Fire Chief has recommended the purchase of a new ambulance for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Fairfield Township; and

WHEREAS: The Board has determined that the current budget can sustain this purchase out of the EMS Fund, 2281;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows:

- SECTION 1: The Board of Trustees hereby approves the purchase of 2026 Ford F450 Ambulance from Medix Specialty Vehicles, for the Fire Department at a cost not to exceed \$300,000.00, per State Contract to be paid out of EMS Fund 2281, and included herein as Attachment "A".
- The Board hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.
- SECTION 3: This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.
- SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 5:** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

For the Boards consideration, we are requesting \$289,343.33 for a Type III ambulance through Medix Specialty Vehicles.

The cost of the Type III ambulance is \$211,938.00

With additional equipment as outlined below.

Stryker Load System and Cot, \$63,725.19

Mobile Radio, Butler County, \$5,680.14

Vehicle wrap, TBD, \$8,000(estimate, likely to be lower, awaiting official quote)

Bringing the total to \$289,343.33

This is an overall savings of \$123,827.91, by switching from a Type I to a Type III ambulance.
