Mr. McAbee - I still say the trend is not good. We need to monitor every expenditure. We really didn't need to borrow the money. That's why I voted against it. We had the money. Or we need to go back to the ballot to ask for money but I'm not in favor of that.

Mrs. Berding - The loan was taken out to protect the general fund.

Mrs. Hartkemeyer - Maybe we could pay this loan off earlier. Protecting the general fund is important. No one is interested in going back to the voters.
