PRESENTATIONS

Auditor's First Quarter Update – Julie Joyce-Smith – Property tax bills are due February 28, 2018, they were mailed out the end of January. In the past we had little success with developing a device to detect skimmers. Recently a developer in Florida has designed an app for android phones that uses blue tooth signal to detect skimmers. The app is only available on android but apple is working on it also. The app is free or you can get an upgraded app for \$0.99.

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ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Mrs. Vonderhaar - I have been working with Mr. Geis on the progress of Story Point which is set to start accepting patient in 2019. I have also been working with Habitat for Humanity on ways to improve the 5 points area. Been working with the Fire and Police Departments on staffing. Working on the Firehouse project which the Trustees decided this would be discussed at the next meeting so the public is made aware of the plans.

Fire Department

Chief Thomas – Presented monthly report and his annual report. A digital copy of the annual report is on the website. I have talked to Vogelpohl about the breathing apparatus equipment and the fire fighters are being fitted for their masks.

Trustee McAbee – asked the Chief if he had an estimate for fixing the life squad, chief said he is still working on it. Problem being if I take it to the place close to us with a quote, it can void the warranty. It looks like it will be April time frame before they can get it in the shop.

Police Department

Chief Chabali – January was a record month with 140 arrests. Outstanding issues are still one missing person without any leads. We had a drug bust with 30 grams of heroin. The new windows have been installed and has definitely helped with the draft.

We now have 5 solid candidates for a Police Officer position, 2 are being processed the other 3 are on reserve.

We are sending officers to the funeral this Friday for the officers that recently lost their lives in the line of duty.

Service Department

Jeff Bennett – Lots of activity with snow events. I am working on the Durapatch list to be ready by April 1, 2018. The dog park benches have been assembled.

Trustee Berding – Stated the Service Department has done an excellent job with snow removal. Thank you!

Trustee McAbee – Asked Mr. Bennett to present a list of Durapatch areas as soon as possible.

Zoning Department

Chuck Goins - 13 permits were approved for the month of January. The application for the apartments has been withdrawn a second time. There is still a meeting tomorrow but it's in regards to a use variance on Tylersville Road. The applicant has applied for a variance to have 2 family homes built on 5 acres.

We are working on identifying more areas for the Hardest Hit Fund.

In January Max & Erma's was bought out by a new owner and they are making that location a MacKenzie River Pizza.

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Candy Marcum, 487 Hyde Park Drive, presented a case that her mother's property has water issues. There currently is water a few inches deep in her driveway and her mother cannot get in and out of her house when it freezes. This has been an ongoing issue for 3 years and Ms. Marcum cannot get resolutions from anyone. She is asking the Board to take action. She stated she feels it could be one of 2 reasons, the moving of a fire hydrant or the repaving of the road. She feels she has not received any help from anyone in the Township.

Robert Jordan, 956 Stahlheber Road, he is the brother of Candy and stated the same concerns as Candy. Robert discussed the ways he has went about trying to get the Township and Butler County to work with him to resolve this water issue.

Trustee Berding – Stated she will work on this issue and have something to report at the next meeting.
