ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Mrs. Vonderhaar - I provided an economic development update. I met with the Veteran's group regarding location of the Veterans Memorial Park. Trustee Berding can give an update on this. Our first movie night of the summer was cancelled due to poor weather. The Community Engagement Committee met and provided a report which I will forward to the Board. The Zoning Resolution was sent out to the Board today. We can do the ground breaking ceremony for the new firehouse anytime. We will look at setting a date at our July meeting.

Trustee Berding – In reference to the Fairfax Avenue property we had a meeting the end of May with the Jordan residents. The County Engineers office, Ken Geis, Larry Barbiere met along with Julie and I. It was recommended, for a short term solution, our Service Department go and use our camera to look and see what is going on. Our Service Department went out the next day and did some work. We don't have a long term solution at this point. The Township will be applying for the block grant again this year.

Trustee McAbee – Expressed concern about the amount of JEDD money being received. Want to make sure we are receiving the correct amount of money from our businesses.

Mrs. Vonderhaar – The Fiscal Office should be receiving a list of business that are contributing to the JEDD. Mrs. Vonderhaar will get with Ms. Schultz to make sure the list that is being sent is correct.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Fire Department

Chief Thomas – Submitted monthly written report. Working on the hiring process with the Police Department to get background check for remaining candidates. We are able to hire the second employee tonight. We have ranked the remaining candidates and moving them to the background check process. Hope to have this done before the end of the summer.

Trustee McAbee – Do we have any additional part time position being filled? **Chief Thomas** – We have 3 in the process to be ready for the next meeting.

Police Department

Chief Chabali - Submitted our report. We have two candidates awaiting results of the medical. We now need a third candidate due to Officer Robbins leaving. We have a detective dedicated to helping the Fire Chief with background checks. We will finalize acceptance of Officer Robbins resignation.

We have resolutions to appoint Anita Snyder and Michelle Couch full time Police Clerk positions with a \$5.00 per hour increase with no medical benefits. We really need their help. Both ladies are great employees that work well together.

Trustee McAbee – We usually create positions before hiring or promoting from within. Do we have in the budget to go from part time to full time? Usually we see their reviews first.

Regular Trustee Meeting

Held Year Trustee Berding – We had an individual budgeted that didn't come back. I am in favor of doing what it takes to properly run the department. I am very appreciative of these ladies and the excellent work they have done.

Trustee Hartkemeyer – I reviewed your report and did have some questions, which you responded with answers. Thank you for your promptness in getting back with me. I am in favor of moving forward and appreciate having great dedicated employees.

Service Department

Jeff Bennett – The Durapatch has been completed with the \$45,000.00 that was allotted in the budget. The only area they didn't get accomplished were a few streets in Weathered Oak and a few back behind Home Depot. Met with fencing companies to install fencing around the recycling bins at the Police Department. I haven't received the estimates yet. This would be a "U" shaped fencing around the recycle bins to keep trash from blowing into the Dog Park.

ADA compliant sidewalks were completed last Friday. We are trying to get crosswalk markings but haven't heard back.

Received an e-mail about getting an Eagle Scout to build a bench or swing in dedication to Mr. McKendry, possibly meeting on the 27th.

Trustee McAbee – Back to the Durapatch, maybe next year they can post no parking signs.

Jeff Bennett – Will explore the cost of finishing up the streets that didn't get finished. Our next process is crack seal, will get this finished when the machine is available.

We are currently down a mower trim tractor, hoping to have the problem diagnosed by this Friday. We have been using weed eaters for now, costs \$14,000.00 a month to rent one. We will need to budget for new mower next year, base price is \$110,000.00.

Zoning Department

Chuck Goins — Our complaints have been increasing with the warn weather. Our intern has been busy following up with the complaints and taking pictures. 25 zoning permits were approved in May. The Zoning Appeals Board met and approved the variance request by Community Christian Church to create a multiuse building that exceeded the max size allowed.

Trustee McAbee – Trash and tall grass by Menards, not sure who owns that property. Chuck will research and take care of that.

- SECTION 1: The Board does hereby authorize the acceptance of payments by "financial transaction devices," as defined in R.C. 503.55(A)(1), for Township expenses in the exercise of their discretion set forth in this Resolution, pursuant to R.C.503.55.
- SECTION 2: The Board does hereby authorize the following Fairfield Township Offices, to accept payments by financial transaction devices, if they so choose:

 Administrative and Fiscal Offices.
- SECTION 3: The Board does hereby authorize any expense considered to be a "township expense" under Revised Code § 503.55 including, but not limited to fees, costs, assessments, fines, penalties, payments, or any other expense a person owes or otherwise pays to a township to be paid by means of a financial transaction device.
- SECTION 4: The Board does hereby authorize the following types of financial transaction devices to be accepted, upon the condition that an agreement setting forth the terms and conditions for payment using such financial transaction device is entered into with the issuing financial institution: MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover Card (Credit or Debit cards); and electronic checks.
- SECTION 5: This Resolution expressly recognizes that each Township Office shall be free to establish which financial transaction devices the Office will honor and that the acceptance of financial transaction devices need not be uniform among different types of Township expenses.
- SECTION 6: The Board does hereby authorize a surcharge or convenience fee to be charged for use of a financial transaction device. The amount authorized as a surcharge or convenience fee shall be determined by the Board after selection of a financial institution to facilitate the Township's financial transaction devices program.
- SECTION 7: Township Offices accepting payment by financial transaction devices shall comply with the requirements of R.C. 503.55€ regarding notice to customers. Uniform application of surcharge or convenience fees among different types of Township expenses is not required.
- SECTION 8: The Board does hereby require that, should a payment by financial transaction device by returned or dishonored for any reason, such fact shall result in the imposition of a penalty of \$20.00 or payment of the amount necessary to reimburse the Township for banking charges, legal fees, and/or other expenses incurred by the Township in collecting the returned or dishonored payment. These remedies and procedures are in addition to any other available civil or criminal remedies by law.
