**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO POST ADVERTISEMENT
FOR THE POLICE CHIEF POSITION.**

WHEREAS: As of March 28, 2017, the position of Police Chief has been vacant;

WHEREAS: Advertisement for the Police Chief position is necessary to start the process of evaluating potential chiefs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Administrator to post advertisement for the Police Chief position.

SECTION 2: The Trustees of Fairfield Township do hereby dispense with the requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to RC 504.10, and do authorize the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3: This resolution is the subject of the general authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the Ohio Revised Code and not the specific authority granted to the Board of Trustees through the status as a Limited Home Rule Township.



SECTION 5: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.






